Australia and the Cold War – The Petrov Affair	<p>Created by Frances Moore and maintained by the Museum of Australian Democracy, this is a Rich Task exploring the Cold War; and Post World War II Australia, particularly Australia’s response to communism. The Rich Task includes The Case; The Defection; and The Royal Commission. There is a WebQuest targeted at students in Years 9 – 12. 


